Purposes of the data collection

Recipients

Storage period

Rights of the data subject

Withdrawal of consent

You can suspend the processing covered by this Privacy Policy at any time by writing to the Data Controller expressing your intention to do so, without prejudice to transactions lawfully carried out up to that point.

Right to complain
